5 Franchise Fee: This is a 6% fee the City of Winter Park collects from customers to compensate the community for using the rights-of-way. 100 % of this fee is sent back to the local community.

6 Electric Utility Tax: In accordance with state law, a county/municipality may levy a 10% tax on the purchase of electricity within that area. 100% of this tax is paid directly to your county/municipality. The City of Winter Park does not keep any county utility taxes.
