We have broken down the residential rate so you can clearly see the costs for the first 1,000 kWh as compared to the costs for kWh above 1,000. This charge is applicable whether or not electricity is used. 4 Gross Receipts Tax: This 2.5641% tax is collected in accordance with the Florida State Statues.
