construction & debris materials quick guide



Ordinance 3055-16, Chapter 82 of the Code of Ordinances, governs solid waste, including construction & debris (c&d) materials. These materials are generated when new building and civil-engineering structures* are built or existing buildings and civil-engineering structures* are renovated or demolished including deconstruction activities. [*Civil-engineering structures include public works projects such as streets and highways, bridges, utility plants, piers and dams.]

c&d waste hauler guidelines

- Obtain a non-exclusive permit [see other side] [for collecting or transporting commercial recyclable materials, source separated recyclable construction and demolitions debris, or non-exclusive construction and demolition debris]
- Become a registered hauler [requires annual renewal]
- Provide a c&d monthly report
 - [submit to sustainability@cityofwinterpark.org]
- Carry an acceptable insurance policy & business certificate

Discard only approved materials in dumpster or roll off container

[NOT solid waste or residential recycling]

Use Waste Pro[®] for c&d dumpsters and roll off containers [commercial c&d recyclable materials ONLY persuant current city ordinance]

c&d registered waste haulers

The table below outlines projects requiring the use of the city's contract hauler, Waste Pro[®]. The ordinance also requires all non-franchise waste haulers operating within the City of Winter Park to register with the Natural Resources & Sustainability Department, unless exempt by the State of Florida. Please note that all legal remedies available will be utilized to resolve any issues that may arise, including revoking of non-franchise waste hauler permit for up to three years.

Single Family/Duplex/Triplex [any residential property that has a renovation/upgrade completed]	Any registered hauler	Yes [must be registered & provide monthly reporting]
Single Family [empty lot that has never been built on]	Waste Pro	No
Commercial new construction & demolition recyclables [site separated ONLY] [every owner or tenant of a commercial establishment, or owner or developer that has c&d recyclables]	Any hauler [recyclables only]	Yes [may be exempt by state]
Commercial new construction & demolition solid waste [every owner or tenant of a commercial establishment, or owner or developer of a demolition site with the exception of existing residential units as noted in Sec 82-36(b)(4), shall utilize the services of the city's franchise (Waste Pro) for collection and removal of solid waste, including c&d materials.]	Waste Pro	No
