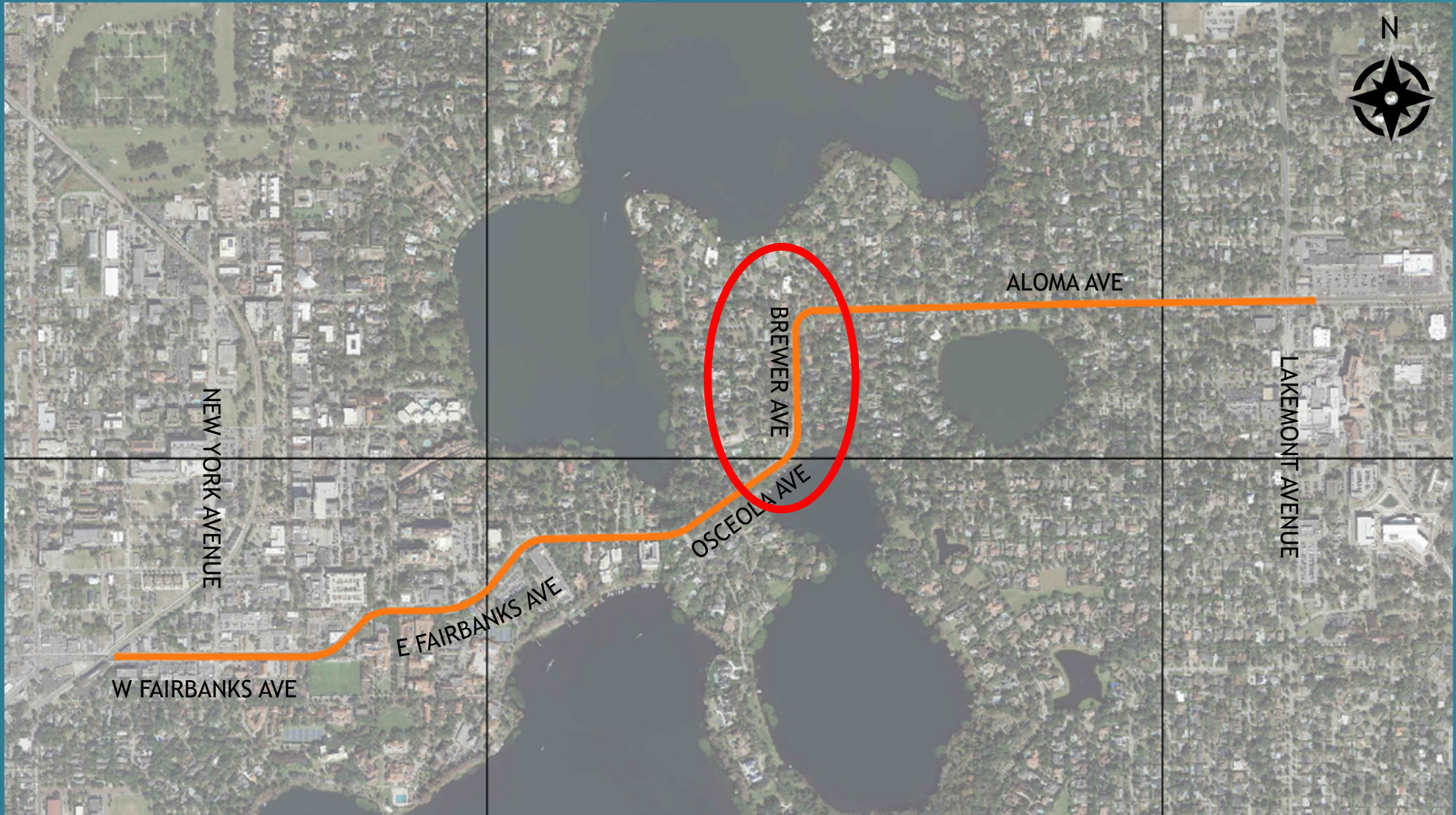

Why are we here?

History

- ▶ Overhead flashing warning signs on the approaches to Brewer Avenue in both directions
- ▶ City of Winter Park has previously made requests to the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for traffic signals along SR426
 - ▶ Vicinity of Trismen Terrace
 - ▶ Henkel Circle
- ▶ FDOT reviewed the requests but stated these requests were unwarranted based on their evaluation criteria





What has been done recently?

Action Taken

- ▶ FDOT performed a speed study along Brewer Avenue in December 2020
 - ▶ Study resulted in the installation of a speed feedback sign on eastbound Brewer Avenue (installed in June 2021)



Action Taken

- ▶ Winter Park Police Department (WPPD) enforcement

Action Taken

- ▶ City of Winter Park requested additional signage along SR426 in advance of the Brewer's Curve section
 - ▶ FDOT installed chevrons in November 2021



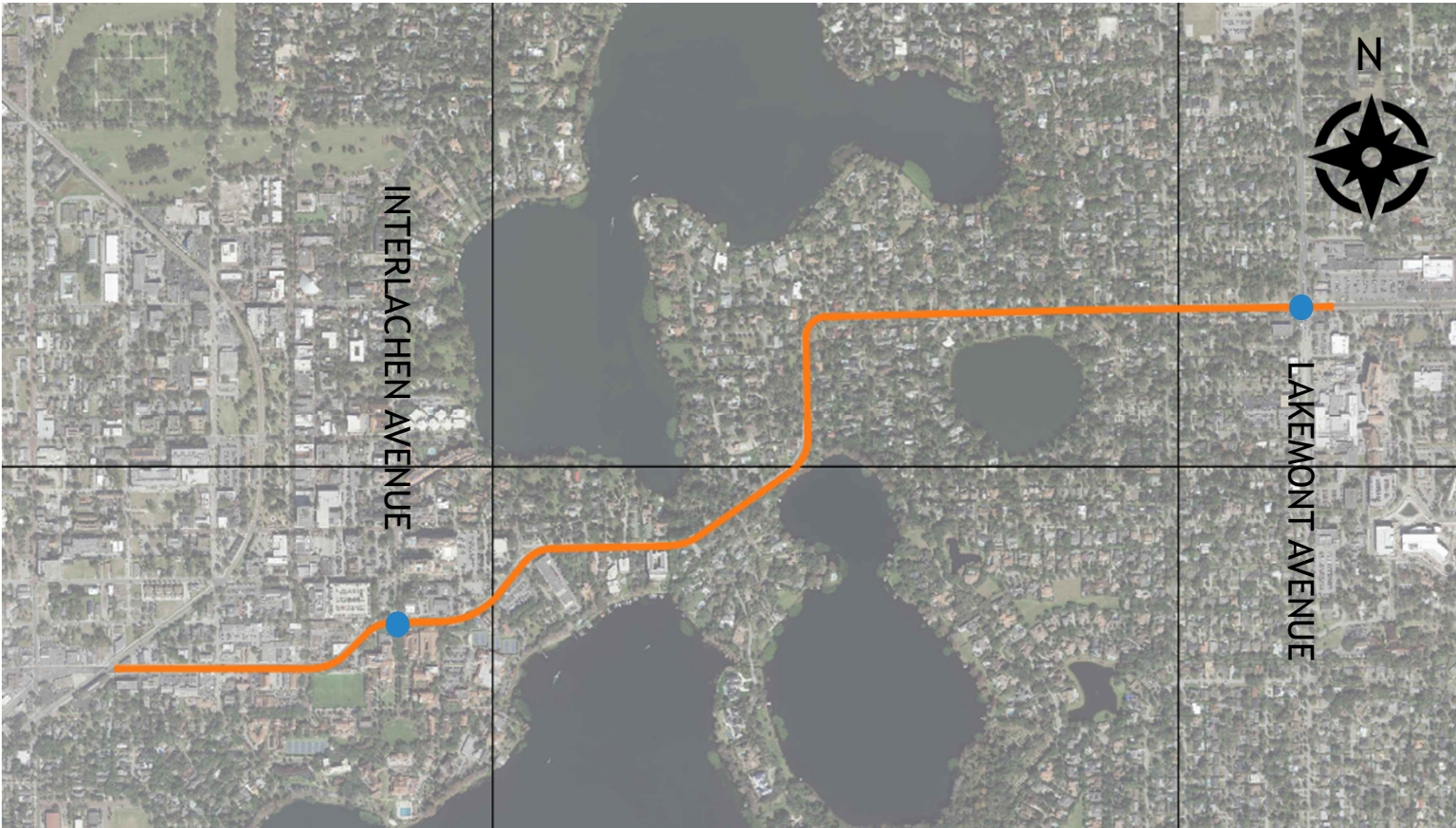
Action Taken

- ▶ City also requested additional illumination to guardrail
 - ▶ FDOT installed enhancements to the guardrail and single post mounted signs in December 2021



Action Taken

- ▶ City of Winter Park and FDOT have had multiple meetings to discuss a corridor study
 - ▶ Analyze SR426 from Interlachen Avenue to Lakemont Avenue





What is currently under consideration?

Under Consideration

- ▶ Corridor Study

- ▶ Project was brought forward for consideration but did not receive funding this fiscal year
- ▶ FDOT is hopeful of funding for next fiscal year

Under Consideration

- ▶ Speed Tables
 - ▶ FDOT has proposed speed tables as a potential interim measure
 - ▶ City Staff is currently discussing this option with the Winter Park Fire Department
