



LOST/STOLEN WALLET INVENTORY & EMERGENCY CHECKLIST

Don't Lose These Names & Numbers: Fill out this personal guide & keep it in a **safe** place. If your wallet/purse is lost or stolen you'll know who to call and what to say. When traveling, take along a similar list, but don't include account #s or expiration dates. Consider leaving a copy of your travel list with a **trusted** family friend or relative (plus a driving route map or flight/bus/train trip info).

Checking Accounts — Immediately call to cancel checking accounts and start new ones.
