PARKING SPACE TIME LIMITS TO BE MONITORED IN DOWNTOWN

September 12, 2018 – Beginning October 1, 2018, the Winter Park Police Department will implement new parking enforcement procedures in the downtown business district along and around Park Avenue. The downtown business district boundaries include Interlachen Avenue on the east, Fairbanks Avenue on the south, New York Avenue on the west, and Swoope Avenue on the north. Parking space time limits that are prominently posted in this area will be enforced via a new software program which enables the parking enforcement officer to more efficiently monitor the length of time a car sits in one parking spot. Prior to expiration of the time limit allotted for a parking space, the car must be relocated to a new parking space at least 500 feet away. Citations will be issued for cars that remain in parking spots longer than the allotted time, or do not relocate at least 500 feet from the original parking space.
