Armed Robbery Arrest

On Tuesday, April 9, 2019 at 2:50 pm, the Winter Park Police Department responded to a Robbery with a Firearm that had just occurred in the 1300 Block of South Orlando Avenue, Winter Park, Florida.

Responding officers located the suspect's vehicle as it was leaving the area and officers attempted to conduct a traffic stop. During the incident, officers learned that the vehicle being used by the suspect was stolen the previous day out of Seminole County. The suspect failed to stop for officers and fled. During his flight, the suspect crashed into another vehicle that was occupied by two innocent bystanders. That crash is currently being investigated by the Florida Highway Patrol. After the vehicle crash, the suspect exited the stolen vehicle and fled the area on foot. With the assistance of the Seminole County Sheriff's Office, Maitland Police Department and the Casselberry Police Department, we conducted an extensive search for the suspect who evaded apprehension that evening.

Detectives with the Winter Park Criminal Investigations Unit began an immediate investigation into the incident. With the help of the Orange County Sheriff's Office Felony Squad, the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) Biology Section, the Seminole County Sheriff's Office, the Florida Highway Patrol (FHP) and the Orlando Police Department Latent Examinations Unit, detectives established probable cause that Defendant Andrake Deon Bryant Jr. committed multiple offenses during the armed

robbery of the victim. Defendant Andrade Deon Bryant Jr. was out on bond for felony charges from Seminole County at the time of the incident. Additionally, he was on felony probation out of Seminole County at the time.

A warrant was issued on April 17, 2019 for Defendant Andrade Deon Bryant Jr., charging him with the following:

Andrade Bryant Jr was arrested today, Thursday, April 25th in Seminole County and taken to the Seminole County jail.
