Suspect Identified and In Custody



Javon Jeremy Hines Born 6/01/1989

On November 28, 2023 at approximately 1926 hours, the Winter Park Police Department responded to the Winter Park Village located at 520 N. Orlando Avenue for an armed carjacking to a valet attendant. The attendant advised he was parking a red Chevrolet Corvette when the suspect threatened him with a gun and fled in the vehicle. The suspect was located in the vehicle at the 1700 block of Lee Road and after a short foot pursuit was taken into custody. The suspect was identified as **Javon Jeremy Hines, born 6/1/1989**.

Hines was charged with the following Florida State Statute Criminal violations.

- F.S.S-Robbery/Carjacking with a firearm (Felony 1st degree)
- F.S.S-Grand theft of a motor vehicle (Felony 3rd degree)
- F.S.S- Possession of a weapon or ammo by convicted felon (Felony 2nd degree)
- F.S.S- Aggravated assault with intent to commit a felony (Felony 3rd degree)
- F.S.S- Grand theft of a firearm (Felony 3rd degree)
- F.S.S- Grand theft 5k less than 10k (Felony 3rd degree)
- F.S.S-Criminal mischief over 1,000 dollars (Felony 3rd degree)
- F.S.S- Burglary of conveyance-armed (Felony 1st degree)
- F.S.S- Resisting officer without violence-2 counts (Misdemeanor 1st degree)
