Digital Voyeurism

In March, the Winter Park Police received a report of a possible concealed camera in a public access restroom behind 118 S. Park Ave. During the investigation a total of three cameras were found, between March 21st and April 28th. A suspect was identified and, on May 5, 2026, an arrest warrant was obtained for **Nicolas Esparza** (W/M, born 7/28/1998) on the charge of Digital Voyeurism (FSS 810.145 2c). He later turned himself in at the Orange County Jail. Esparza is not an employee of any of the local businesses. While several victims have been identified, there are several other victims who were captured on video who have not been identified. If anyone used the restroom at 118 S. Park Ave on March 21-22, 2026, March 24-25, 2026, or April 28, 2026, and believes they may have been recorded without their permission, please contact Detective Budde at 407-599-3658 or rbudde@cityofwinterpark.org. This investigation remains active and additional charges are pending victim identification.
