

## **Grant Application –Intent to Apply**

On **Monday, June 29**, the City of Winter Park Public Works Department will begin apply for a non-matching grant in the amount of \$200,000 through the Department of Economic Opportunity Rebuild Florida Critical Facility Hardening Program. This grant, if approved, will replace the aging full building generator in the Public Safety Building that houses the Police and Fire Department as well as the Emergency Operations Center and 911 Call Center. This Community Block Grant opportunity is meant to assist local government and state agencies to harden critical buildings that serve a public safety purpose for local communities.

The City of Winter Park Public Safety Building is critical to the safety of residents. A generator ensures that critical operations continue during hurricanes or other events so that emergency management remains intact.
