NOTES

Cost of government for FY2023: General fund \$69,914,000; All Funds \$198,642,000

Money to operate the city comes from property and utility taxes, franchise fees, state revenue sharing, 1/2-cent sales tax and service fees. The money collected is chiefly spent for police and fire protection, salaries of employees and capital improvement projects. Types of taxes paid by local residents are utility tax and property tax. Sewer service fees, water service fees, electric service fees, stormwater utility fees and refuse service fees support services for which the fees are imposed.
