
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INTRODUCTION



Study Objectives

The City of Winter Park has conducted several citizen opinion surveys in the past. These surveys examined some strategic decisions while focusing more on evaluative and tactical issues. During the first meeting between the City of Winter Park Commission and Kerr & Downs Research, the Commission decided that the 2008 Citizen Survey would be more strategic and future oriented while maintaining some focus on tactical and evaluative issues. The primary research objectives of this year's survey are:

- Assess citizens' satisfaction with:
 - Living in Winter Park
 - City of Winter Park government
- Discover how citizens rate performance of City in providing services
- Determine citizens' strategic priorities for:
 - City initiatives
 - City long-term capital investment projects
 - Supporting outside organizations
- Investigate citizens' views on service levels vs. taxes

The content for the questionnaire used in the study was developed in three planning sessions with City Commissioners. Commissioners actively provided input during and between planning sessions. City staff also provided input. The City of Winter Park Commission approved the questionnaire during its meeting on October 13, 2008.

Study Methods

The City of Winter Park Commission determined prior to selecting a consultant that it wanted to conduct an internet-based survey of citizens. The survey methodology was designed to give all households in the City of Winter Park an opportunity to complete the survey. Postcards (see Appendix B) announcing the survey were mailed to all households during the last week of September. Postcards contained the City of Winter Park URL (www.cityofwinterpark.org) where the questionnaire could be accessed. Residents were also given an opportunity to call Kerr & Downs Research to request a hard copy mail version of the questionnaire. Residents could also complete the questionnaire online at the Winter Park Community Center and at the Winter Park Public Library. Questionnaires were also distributed at congregate living facilities.

The methodology in essence made the questionnaire available to each household in the City of Winter Park. Each household was permitted to complete one and only one questionnaire. Each household was given a unique password to guard against households attempting to complete more than one questionnaire. There were a total of eight hundred and eighteen (818) completed questionnaires with 764 completed online and 54 hard copies completed through the mail. The sampling error given a 95% confidence level was ± 3.5 percentage points. It can be argued that the sampling process was a simple random sample with each household serving as a sampling unit. Because Internet surveys create self-selected samples, it is difficult to say without reservation that respondents are representative of all residents of the City of Winter Park. A more defensible characterization of respondents is that they are

most likely more involved in the affairs of the City of Winter Park. Data from the study were weighted to reflect the demographic profile of the residents of the city of Winter Park.

The online questionnaire was posted on October 21, 2008. The questionnaire was in the field for one month as data collection ended on November 21, 2008.

It should be noted that during the data collection period, advocates of the Winter Park Public Library “lobbied” for positive responses on questions about the library. There is no way to measure if this effort had any impact on the study results.



EXECUTIVE SUMMARY



Executive Summary

Here are the main points from the findings:

1. Citizens are very satisfied with living in Winter Park.

Nearly nine out of ten citizens (87%) are “extremely satisfied” or “satisfied” with living in the city of Winter Park. Residents in the northwest quadrant are more likely to express high levels of satisfaction.

2. Citizens are very satisfied with city government.

Eighty-five percent (85%) of residents in the City of Winter Park are “extremely satisfied” or “satisfied” with the overall quality of services they receive from city government. Residents in the northwest quadrant are more likely to express high levels of satisfaction.

3. Satisfaction with specific city services lags overall satisfaction.

The percentages of residents who rated specific city services as “excellent” or “very good” range from a low of 34% for code enforcement to a high of 76% for the Winter Park Library. Conversely, relatively few citizens give “fair” or “poor” ratings to individual services as these percentages range from a low of 1% for fire-rescue services to 26% for streets and drainage. In general, residents living in the southeast and southwest quadrants give higher ratings for individual services, while residents living in the northwest quadrant gave lower ratings across services.

4. Citizens generally feel they are getting a fair deal for their taxes.

Citizens are more likely to be satisfied (54%) than dissatisfied (19%) with how the City of Winter Park spends their tax dollars. Residents living in the southwest are more likely to be satisfied, while residents of the northeast are less satisfied. Only 31% of residents feel taxes are too high for the levels of services they are receiving with residents in the northwest quadrant more likely to feel this way.

5. Top priorities for spending tax dollars are:

- Renovating and improving existing park facilities
- Winter Park Public Library

6. Moderate priorities for spending tax dollars are:

- Underground power line initiative
- Buy new park lands
- Continue the commuter rail initiative
- Renovate the Fairbanks Avenue corridor

7. Residents' preferred strategic initiatives are:

- Continuing the underground power line initiative
- Continuing financial support for the library
- Controlling development and density through codes & zoning

Residents' lowest priorities for strategic initiatives are:

- Partnering with the Orange County Public School system to build a new school to replace the Brookshire School
- Providing financial support to outside cultural, civic, service, and community organizations
- Designating areas and building as historic in an effort to maintain or enhance the historic character of the downtown area

8. Priorities for long-term capital investments are:

- Expanding the Winter Park Public Library
- Beautifying/renovating Fairbanks Avenue

Rebuilding City Hall is the lowest rated long-term capital investment.

9. Citizens are generous in supporting government and community services & organizations as 75% or more of citizens support city government allocating some city funding to the following:

- Winter Park Public Library
- Winter Park Historical Association
- Summer Youth Programs

At least half of citizens also support city funding for the following:

- Chamber of Commerce
- Community Coordinated Care for Children, Inc.
- Merchant associations
- Bach Festival Society
- United Arts
- Winter Park Playhouse
- Welbourne Avenue Day Nursery
- Enzian Theatre

10. Top concerns about neighborhood development are:

- Cutting down mature trees
- Eliminating open space

Just over half of citizens are “very concerned” about these two trends with a greater concern among residents living in the northwest quadrant.

11. Citizens support standards for new/remodeled houses although there are mixed reactions toward the impacts of new & remodeled houses to date.

- 57% of residents agree that new and remodeled houses built in the past few years have enhanced their neighborhoods.
- 35% of residents disagree that recently built/remodeled houses are compatible with other houses in their neighborhoods
- 62% of residents agree that the city should develop standards for new and remodeled houses to preserve the character of the City of Winter Park

12. Fairbanks Avenue Corridor

- 52% support redevelopment and larger than existing commercial buildings in this area
- 61% agree that the city should spend \$1.4 million to renovate and beautify the Fairbanks Avenue corridor

13. Brookshire Elementary School

- More residents prefer to use Orange County Public School money to renovate Brookshire (54%) rather than spending more local money to build a new school (26%)
- More residents believe that all residents (43%) should pay for a new Brookshire School if built than letting all costs be borne by residents who live in that school district (37%)

14. Post Office

- More residents prefer keeping the Post Office as is (52%) than prefer two separate options for building and/or moving parts of the Post Office and freeing up some park land downtown (38%)

15. Underground power lines

- Seven out of ten residents (71%) prefer to continue the underground power line initiative
- More residents (60%) prefer the current rate structure and time line for undergrounding power lines than prefer two separate options for expediting the undergrounding process at a higher tax rate (19%)

16. Commuter rail

- By a 48% to 36% margin residents favor continuing their commitment to the commuter rail even if a dedicated funding source cannot be found by the year 2017 at which point local residents will pay around \$1 million annually to keep the project going.
- By a 48% to 34% margin residents support spending about \$1.4 million to reconstruct the Amtrak building if federal funds are not available.

17. Lowest priorities for spending tax dollars:


- Building a new City Hall
- Building a new Brookshire Elementary School
- Building a new Post Office

18. Services that citizens are more willing to reduce/cut in case of budget cutbacks are:

- Hours of operation of golf course & tennis center
- Number of city-sponsored/hosted cultural events and activities
- Close facilities that require significant financial subsidy
- Programs to attract new businesses and promote existing businesses
- Reduce efforts to provide affordable housing
- Communicate with citizens less frequently about what the city is doing
- Reduce the number of recreation programs the city offers





SATISFACTION WITH WINTER PARK

In 2008, nearly nine out of ten residents (87%) are satisfied with the City of Winter Park, which compares favorably to 74% who shared this opinion in 2006. Nearly as many residents (85%) in 2008 are satisfied with the overall quality of services they receive from the City of Winter Park, which also compares well with 75% who felt this way in 2006. Residents in the northwest quadrant (96%) are more likely to be satisfied with living in Winter Park, while residents of the southwest quadrant (83%) are not as satisfied. Residents in the northwest quadrant are also more likely to be satisfied with City-provided services (97%), while residents in the northeast quadrant have the lowest level of satisfaction (83%).


Overall Satisfaction with the City of Winter Park

Overall Satisfaction with the quality of the services of the City of Winter Park








SATISFACTION WITH SPECIFIC CITY SERVICES


Satisfaction with City of Winter Park provided services ranges from a high of 76% (Excellent + Very Good ratings) to a low of 34%. The top-rated service is the Winter Park Public Library which garners excellent or very good ratings from over three out of four residents (76%). Seven out of ten residents (71%) rate police services as excellent or very good, and nearly as many residents (68%) assign the top two ratings to fire-rescue services. Parks and recreation services are not far behind with 66% excellent or very good ratings.

Fair and poor ratings are the two lowest ratings: Over one in four residents (26%) gives fair or poor ratings to City streets and drainage. Just over two in ten residents give fair or poor ratings to code enforcement (23%) and 19% give electric utility service a fair or poor rating. Only 1% of residents give fire-rescue services a fair or poor rating.


Satisfaction with the City of Winter Park Services Breakdown




Satisfaction with the City of Winter Park Communication Services




Satisfaction with the City of Winter Park Code Enforcement Services




Satisfaction with the City of Winter Park Fire-Rescue Services




Satisfaction with the City of Winter Park Police Services




Satisfaction with the City of Winter Park Electric Utility Services




Satisfaction with the City of Winter Park Water Utility Services




Satisfaction with the City of Winter Park Parks and Recreation Services




Satisfaction with the City of Winter Park Streets and Drainage Services

Ratings by Quadrant


Residents in the southwest quadrant gave the highest ratings for six of the ten city-provided services. For four of the ten services, ratings from residents in the southeast quadrant are higher than ratings from residents in all other quadrants. Compared to other residents, those living in the northwest quadrant give fewer excellent and very good ratings across most city-provided services. In contrast to their overall satisfaction with city services (97% extremely satisfied or satisfied), residents of the northwest quadrant are not as liberal with praise for individual city services. Refer to Table 3 for an inclusive breakdown.



TAXES AND SERVICE LEVELS


Residents are more likely to be satisfied (54%) than dissatisfied (19%) with how the City of Winter Park uses its tax dollars. Residents of the southwest quadrant (64%) are more likely to be satisfied with how the City spends their tax dollars, while residents of the northeast quadrant (28%) are more likely to be dissatisfied.

By a 51% to 40% margin residents are more likely to think taxes are high as opposed to low or just right. When viewed differently, 58% of residents feel the City of Winter Park is providing high quality services that are at least commensurate with the level of taxes being paid. Residents in the northeast quadrant (46%) are more likely to think that taxes are just right or too low. Conversely, 50% of the residents in the northwest quadrant think taxes are too high.


Satisfaction with the City of Winter Park Tax Allocation versus Quality of Service



WILLINGNESS TO PAY HIGHER TAXES TO SUPPORT CITY INITIATIVES

Citizens were presented with a set of nine city initiatives that they could choose either to continue supporting or oppose. A majority of residents are willing to pay more taxes or fees to enhance or continue renovating and improving existing park facilities (66%) and to expand the Winter Park Public Library (65%). A slight majority of residents (51%) are willing to pay higher taxes or fees to continue placing electric lines underground, and exactly half of residents (50%) are willing to pay higher taxes or fees to buy new park areas. A plurality of residents (47%) support higher taxes/fees to fund a commuter rail station and operating costs. A plurality of residents (47%) support higher taxes/fees to fund a commuter rail station and operating costs. Conversely, a plurality of residents (45%) oppose higher taxes or fees to improve the Fairbanks Avenue corridor. Majorities of residents oppose higher taxes or fees to partner with Orange County Public Schools to build a new Brookshire Elementary School (60%), build a new City Hall (62%), or build a new Post Office (58%).






STRATEGIC INITIATIVES

Out of eleven strategic initiatives that can enhance the quality of life in the City of Winter Park, majority of residents support three:

- 63% - Continuing the initiative to place electric lines underground
- 61% - Continuing to provide financial support to the Winter Park Public Library
- 56% - Controlling development and density in certain areas through codes and zoning, to preserve the character of the City of Winter Park

Focus of Tax Allocation for the City of Winter Park Strategic Initiatives



Residents of the southeast quadrant (82%) are much more likely to support continuing the initiative to place electric lines underground. Support for continuing to provide finances to the Winter Park Public Library is more uniform across town ranging from 55% to 64% in all quadrants except the northwest (42%). Support for controlling development and density through codes and zoning is fairly stable across town with a low of 54% in the southeast and a high of 66% in the southwest supporting this initiative.

Support for several initiatives are between 40% and 50% of residents:

- 46% - Improving Fairbanks Avenue between 17-92 and I-4
- 46% - Continuing the city's "Green" initiative
- 44% - Revising building codes to ensure the character and compatibility of neighborhoods
- 42% - Continuing to invest in a commuter rail initiative
- 40% - Determining the best long-term solution to the Winter Park Post Office and Central Park

While one in three residents (35%) supports designating areas and buildings as historic in an effort to maintain or enhance the historic character of the downtown area, relatively few residents support providing financial assistance to outside cultural, civic, service, and community organizations (24%) or partnering with the Orange County Public Schools to build a new school to replace Brookshire Elementary School (17%).




LONG-TERM CAPITAL INVESTMENTS



LONG-TERM CAPITAL INVESTMENTS

The City of Winter Park’s five long-term capital investment alternatives were shown to citizens, who were requested to rank order them from one to five in terms of which were most important to the community. The graph below shows the percentages of citizens who chose each capital investment alternative as their first or second priority for the community.

First or Second Rated Long-Term Investments for the City of Winter Park



Expanding the Winter Park Public Library is citizens’ number one capital investment alternative with 56% selecting it as either the first or second priority for the community. The Fairbanks Avenue renewal and beautification project is the second most important capital investment alternative with 50% of citizens ranking it first or second. Building public parking in the central business district (39% rank it as first or second) narrowly edges out relocating the Post Office to expand the downtown park area (37% rank it first or second). The lowest rated capital investment alternative is building a new City Hall as only 18% of citizens rank this option as first or second in terms of how important it is for the community.

Table 6 shows the percentages of citizens by quadrant who select each capital investment alternative as one of the top two priorities for the good of the community.



CITY FUNDING SUPPORT FOR OUTSIDE ORGANIZATIONS

Citizens were presented with a list of twelve outside organizations and asked if they favor or oppose the City of Winter Park allocating some city funding to each. For all twelve outside organizations, more citizens support than oppose allocating some city funding to them.


Citizens strongly support allocating some city funding to the Winter Park Public Library as 95% support funding the Library from city coffers and only 4% oppose. Citizens in all quadrants strongly support funding the Winter Park Public Library with city monies.

Three out of four citizens (75%) support using city funds to help finance the Winter Park Historical Association. Support for using city funds for the Winter Park Historical Association range from a low of 69% in the northeast quadrant to a high of 86% in the northwest quadrant.

Three out of four citizens (75%) favor allocating city funding to the Summer Youth Programs. Support ranges from 73% of the citizens in the Northeast and southeast quadrants to 88% of the citizens in the northwest quadrant.

Six in ten citizens (60%) believe that some city funding should be given to the Winter Park Chamber of Commerce. Support for using city funding for the Winter Park Chamber of Commerce varies from a low of 42% in the southwest quadrant to a high of 76% in the southeast quadrant.

Support of Organizations outside the City of Winter Park



The rest of the outside organizations receive support from about half of citizens for getting City funding:

- 56% – Community Coordinated Care for Children, Inc.
- 54% - Winter Park Merchant Associations
- 54% - Bach Festival Society
- 53% - United Arts
- 52% - Winter Park Playhouse
- 51% - Welbourne Avenue Day Nursery
- 50% - Enzian Theatre
- 47% - Crealde School of Art



FUNDING STRATEGY

Citizens prefer that outside organizations appeal to the City Commission on an annual basis for their City funding. Exactly half of citizens (50%) prefer annual requests for funding for outside organizations, while only 18% believe outside organizations should be funded for a 5-year period so the organizations can better plan their operational and capital strategies. One in five citizens (21%) voiced their opposition to funding outside organizations through this question. Opposition to funding outside organizations peaks in the northwest quadrant where 40% of citizens prefer not to give City funding to these groups.

Support of Monies for Organizations outside the City of Winter Park




LIBRARY FUNDING STRATEGY

In the 2007 fiscal year, the City of Winter Park allocated approximately \$1.3 million to the Winter Park Public Library. Funding for the library is currently provided on an annual request and approval basis. An alternative funding mechanism that can introduce more stability into the funding stream available for the library is to have a designated millage rate solely for the Winter Park Public Library.


A majority of citizens (54%) prefer that the library continue to receive funding on a yearly request basis. Three in ten citizens (31%) favor introducing a designated millage rate for the library. A majority of residents in the northeast (62%) and southeast (58%) quadrants favor annual funding, while a plurality of citizens in the northwest quadrant also favor this funding mechanism. A plurality of citizens in the southwest quadrant (48%) favor a designated millage rate for funding the Winter Park Public Library.

TRENDS AFFECTING NEIGHBORHOOD CHARACTER



TRENDS AFFECTING NEIGHBORHOOD CHARACTER


Citizens were given an opportunity to respond to several trends that seem to be influencing the character of Winter Park neighborhoods. The majority of citizens express at least some concern with all neighborhood trends included in the survey as shown below:

At least somewhat concerned with trend

	Trend
90%	Cutting down mature trees to make room for larger houses
85%	Eliminating open yards or green space to make room for larger houses
67%	Building larger new or remodeled houses
63%	Demolishing smaller houses
62%	Demolishing older homes to make way for newer houses

Percentages of citizens who are “very concerned” with each of these trends are considerably smaller as shown in the graph below. However, over half of citizens are “very concerned” with demolishing smaller houses and eliminating open yards or green space to make room for larger houses.


REMODELED HOUSES

Additional questions about remodeled houses and their effect on neighborhoods were included in the survey. Citizens appear to have mixed feelings about new and remodeled houses. Over half of citizens (57%) believe new and remodeled houses enhance Winter Park’s neighborhoods, yet 62% of citizens want the City of Winter Park to develop standards for new and remodeled houses and buildings to preserve the character of Winter Park. Only 42% of citizens feel that new and remodeled houses built in the past few years are compatible with other homes in their neighborhoods. Reactions to neighborhood trends across the four quadrants of the City of Winter Park are shown in Table 10.




Agreement on whether New and Remodeled Homes have enhanced Neighborhoods



Agreement on whether New and Remodeled Homes are Compatible with Homes in Particular Neighborhoods




Agreement with Developing Standards for New and Remodeled Homes to Preserve the Character of Winter Park








By a 52% to 32% margin, citizens support redevelopment and larger than existing commercial buildings along the Fairbanks Avenue corridor between US 17-92 and Interstate 4. Support for this issue peaks in the southwest quadrant (61%) and is lowest in the northwest quadrant (40%).

Citizens also agree (by a 61% to 24% margin) that the City of Winter Park should spend \$1.4 million to renovate and beautify the Fairbanks Avenue corridor to spur economic development in that area. Support for this initiative is greatest in the southwest quadrant (78%) and least in the northwest and northeast quadrants (54%).


Agreement with the Allocation of funds toward the Renovation of the Fairbanks Avenue Corridor



It should also be noted that, when presented with eleven possible initiatives for the City of Winter Park to pursue (see page 29), 46% of citizens choose “Improving the Fairbanks Avenue area by planting trees, widening medians, extending the sewer, etc., to enhance the main gateway to the City of Winter Park.” Support for various initiatives ranges from 63% for undergrounding electric lines to 17% for partnering with Orange County Public Schools to build a new Brookshire Elementary School. Across the eleven initiatives, improving the Fairbanks Avenue corridor is rated fourth.

BROOKSHIRE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

Citizens were given a choice between renovating the Brookshire Elementary School solely on the Orange County Public School budget or building a new school that will cost the City of Winter Park between two and four million dollars. A majority of citizens (54%) support renovating the school and using only Orange County Public School funding. One in four citizens (26%) wants the City of Winter Park to invest the additional funds to build a new school. Support for renovating is highest in the northeast quadrant (64%), while support for building a new school is highest in the southeast quadrant (37%).

Renovation of Brookshire Elementary School or Building a New School



PAYING FOR BROOKSHIRE SCHOOL

Citizens of the City of Winter Park are mixed in their feelings about who should pay for a new Brookshire School if it were built: 43% say all residents should pay, while 37% maintain that costs should be borne by property owners in the Brookshire Elementary School area. A majority of residents in the southeast quadrant (60%) feel all residents should share in the cost of a new school, while a majority of residents in the northeast (51%) quadrant believe costs should be shouldered only by residents who live in that school district.

Payment for the Improvements to Brookshire Elementary School






A slim majority of citizens (52%) wish to keep the retail and distribution center of the Winter Park Post Office exactly as is. About one in five citizens (19%) prefers to build a new retail post office downtown and move the distribution part of the post office to another location (freeing up one acre of parkland downtown) given a \$4 to \$5 million price tag. Another 19% prefer to build a new retail post office and distribution center outside the downtown area (freeing up two acres of parkland) at a cost of \$4 to \$5 million.

Improvement Options for the City of Winter Park Post Office






By a sizeable majority (71% to 21%), citizens of the City of Winter Park favor continuing the underground electric initiative. Support for this initiative is highest in the southeast (79%) and southwest (76%) quadrants and lowest in the northwest quadrant (46%).

Agreement with the Continuation of the Underground Power Lines Initiative



PAYMENT OPTIONS

Out of several payment options, most citizens (60%) prefer to maintain the existing electric rate structure that will result in most power lines being placed underground over the next 25 years. Only 15% of citizens opined in this question that they do not want the City of Winter Park to continue placing power lines underground. There is little support for accelerating the process of placing power lines underground by increasing the rate structure. Only one in ten citizens (9%) favors adding a 5% surcharge to the electric bill in return for accelerating the process from 25 to 15 years. Another one in ten citizens (10%) favors adding a 10% surcharge that will reduce the timeline for undergrounding power lines to 10 years.

Payment Preferences for the Underground Power Lines Initiative







The City of Winter Park agreed to provide financial support for a commuter rail system. While operating costs through the year 2017 are covered by the Florida Department of Transportation, the City of Winter Park may need to contribute an estimated \$1 million per year after 2017 if a dedicated funding source for commuter rail cannot be found. By a 48% to 36% margin, citizens of Winter Park favor continued support for the commuter rail project in the absence of a dedicated funding source in the year 2017. Citizens in all quadrants except the northwest support the commuter rail project. Support is greatest in the southwest quadrant with 63% of citizens favoring to continue support for commuter rail after 2017 even without a dedicated funding source.

Agree to Continue the Commuter Rail System Initiative




Citizens also support spending approximately \$1.4 million (if federal funds are not available) to reconstruct the Amtrak building in Craftsman-style to make it stylistically consistent with the character of Winter Park. Proponents outnumber opponents 48% to 34%. Support for funding the reconstruction of the station is highest in the southwest quadrant (61%) and lowest in the northwest quadrant (38%).

CUTTING CITY SERVICES

In the event that the City of Winter Park has to make budget cuts resulting in cuts in service levels, citizens were queried regarding which services they are willing to have reduced. Two services stand out above the rest that citizens are willing to reduce: 1) hours of operation of the golf course and tennis center and 2) number of city-sponsored/hosted cultural events and activities. Approximately six in ten citizens are willing to see these two services reduced.

Approximately four in ten citizens are willing to have service levels for the following reduced:


- 42% - Close facilities that require significant financial subsidy
- 39% - Cut programs to attract new businesses and promote existing businesses
- 39% - Reduce efforts to provide affordable housing
- 38% - Communicate with citizens less frequently about what the city is doing
- 36% - Reduce the number of recreation programs the city offers

City-provided services that citizens are least willing to cut are:

- 0% - Accept a slower response time for services from the Fire-Rescue Department
- 2% - Accept slower response time to water and sewer leaks
- 3% - Accept slower response time to restore power outages
- 5% - Reduce efforts to make sure storm drains function properly after heavy rains.
- 6% - Reduce the number of police, patrol hours, an patrol cars on the streets



Services that People are Willing to Do Without if the City Budget Must be Cut









Demographic Breakdown: Race





Demographic Breakdown: Household Income





Demographic Breakdown: Age








