1. Non-Action Items to be discussed

The Transportation Advisory Board will hold a work session to discuss the following:

Agenda:

1. Blake Street path from Fairbanks Ave. to New York Ave. The FDOT has agreed to an 8 foot wide path with a fence separating the path from the railroad tracks. This path replaces the closed Blake Street roadway and is intended for walkers and cyclists.
2. Sidewalk, pathway, east side of Farmer's Market from New York Ave. to New England Ave.
3. Sidewalk, pathway, along railroad to access to the Sunrail Station. The FDOT has denied the construction of a sidewalk, pathway, or trail within the railroad right of way.

This work session is scheduled for May 24, 2016, from 8:30 – 9:30 am. Meet in the Chapman Room at City Hall.
