I. ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS

Call to Order: Chm. Erne called the meeting to order at 3:35 p.m.

Approval of Minutes:

Chm. Erne asked for approval of the December 11, 2017, minutes. Mr. Barley moved to approve the minutes as revised, Ms. Mellen seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously with a vote of 6-0.

Chair's Report – David Erne

Chm. Erne announced a webinar next week, January 16, 2018, "Linking Bike Share & Transit." sponsored by NACTO,

Staff's Report Butch Margraf – Project Highlights – January 11, 2018

- **Bike to Work Day** Mr. Margraf reviewed the announcement that will appear in the February City Update and Utility Bill. Mr. Margraf will provide the revised announcement to Ms. Howard.
- **Fairbanks/Denning Signal** Mr. Margraf explained the signal changes and reasons why.
- Morse and New York Mr. Margraf responded to questions regarding the removal of the traffic signal and addition of stop signs at the intersection.
- **Orange Ave** The Board requested information about a crash that took place on Orange Ave. Due to the ongoing investigation Sgt. Hershone could only provide minimal details. Mr. Margraf commented that FDOT and City will be looking at possible changes to Orange Ave. The Board requested quarterly accident reports.

Northeast Connector – The Board requested an update on the status of the Northeast Connector. The condition, required by motion and unanimous vote by the TAB Board, to set aside vacant land wide enough to use as a multi-use path, to be known as the Northeast Connector, for the purpose of connecting the St. Andrews Trail north to Lakemont Ave, was provided to the Planning and Zoning Board (P & Z) and to the Mayflower as a condition for P & Z approval. The P & Z Board at the P & Z meeting on January 4, 2018 voted for recommendation to approve Future Land Use, Zoning, and Preliminary and Final Conditional Use request with the following conditions: That the Mayflower Retirement Community explore options to create a northeast connector trail on the Mayflower Retirement Center property of 12

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feet wide with a three foot buffer on each side, consistent with the proposed St. Andrews Trail, as recommended by the Transportation Advisory Board.

- St. Andrew's Trail Developing conceptual exhibits for agreement document to proceed with the project.
- Ward Park/Project Wellness Trail Data collection and Design of the trail has commenced.
- **17-92 (Orlando Avenue) PD&E update** This project has been advanced to the Design Phase. Project will be advertised as a corridor improvement project for bids on January 22, 2018.
- **Fairbanks Ave Bowling Alley Property Lane Extension** This project is in design. The FDOT and City are documentation for property transfer.
- **Denning Drive Phase 1** Construction of Phase One is near completion. Landscape and irrigation being constructed.
- **17-92 at Morse Blvd. Intersection Upgrade** Construction mast arms plans are in final review at FDOT, This project includes new mast arms for the signal and enhanced pedestrian crosswalks.
- 17-92 at Canton Ave. Emergency Signal Study is in final review at FDOT.
- Cady Way Trail Crossing at Cady Way Construction for RRFB at bike trail crossing is complete.
- Cady Way Trail Crossing at Summerfield Road Construction for RRFB at crossing is complete.
- Lakemont Ave at Westminster Towers Crosswalk The City is acquiring materials for relocation of the existing crosswalk and construction of the pedestrian crossing signals.
- Active Arterial Management (AAM) / Integrated Corridor Management (ICM) This is an ongoing partnership between FDOT, the City of Winter Park, and other adjacent municipalities.
- Transit Signal Priority (TSP) This is an ongoing partnership between FDOT and the City.
- **Bicycle Wayfinding** Adjustments to sign distances and destinations are being considered.
- Scenic Boat Tour Construction of ramp is complete. Construction of handrails in process. Construction of stairs to supplement ramp is in construction.

Transportation Project List/Sidewalk Policy

Mr. Margraf does not have the prioritized list available today so the Board moved on to discuss the Sidewalk Policy.

Mr. Margraf distributed handouts that cover the level of service adopted by the City for sidewalk coverage, pedestrians, bicycles and transit. He reviewed the sidewalk coverage percentages for the arterial and connector roads. He explained the system he used to revise, based on the Board's comments at the January 9, 2018 work session, the current sidewalk policy. Discussion ensued. The Board suggested blending the Huntsville and City of Winter Park sidewalk policies together and focusing on public parks, transit centers, and community activities centers.

The Board discussed the Northeast Connecter after hearing what the P&Z Board recommended. The Board asked Mr. Margraf to clarify with Jeff Briggs what exactly the Board's motion said before it goes before the City Commission.

Work Session for Mobility Plan and Sidewalk Policy

Two topics were discussed

- 1. Discussion of Mobility Plan
- 2. Sidewalk Policy

Mr. Margraf stated that the two topics for discussion are the Mobility Plan and Sidewalk policy. He asked the Board's indulgence in allowing a resident to speak, before the discussion began, since this work session was being held at the time of a regular meeting. The Board agreed.

Rick Hoffman, Waterfall Cove Condos – Lee Road, spoke regarding current traffic concerns and the impact to traffic of new development in the area.

Mr. Margraf mentioned that in the Transportation Element of the Comp Plan, the City adopted a level of service for sidewalks based on coverage percentage throughout the City. Mr. Margraf reviewed handouts containing additional details.

The Board discussed aspects of the sidewalk policy including need for sidewalks vs every street get sidewalks, criteria for sidewalks, size of buffers, policy verbiage, how sidewalks are installed, costs, installation priority, connectivity, and authority to install sidewalks in City rights of way when an adjacent property owner objects. Board suggested staff pull the ideas shared at this meeting into a draft form and present at the next meeting for review.

Project Updates by Staff for February 13, 2018 Transportation Advisory Board Meeting

St Andrews Trail (LAP) – Met with Design Consultant KCG February 2, 2018 to update agreement exhibits. Conferred with attorney on exhibits.

Ward Park / Project Wellness Trail – Data Collection and Design of the trail has commenced. An archeological survey is scheduled and required.

17-92 (Orlando Avenue) Master Plan – This project was advertised for Design Phase January 22,
2018. Design Consultant to be contracted with FDOT in June 2018.

Fairbanks Ave Bowling Alley property Lane Extension – This project is in design. Preliminary Design Plans to City for review late February 2018.

Denning Drive Phase 1 – Construction of Phase One is near completion. Landscape and irrigation completed. Striping is scheduled for week of February 12.

Denning Drive Phase II – Construction of Phase II begins February 5, 2018 with southbound Lynx bus stops at MLK Park.

1792 at Morse Blvd Intersection Upgrade – FDOT final design comments for mast arm plans provided to City for review and response. This project includes new mast arms for the signal and enhanced pedestrian crosswalks.

1792 at Canton Ave Emergency Signal – The need for an Emergency Signal has been justified with the FDOT. GPS pre-emption is being evaluated as an alternative.

Cady Way Trail Crossings at Cady Way and Summerfield Road - Construction of RRFBs at bike trail crossings complete.

Northeast Connector – The Mayflower Expansion project must come back to P & Z for Conditional Use approvals before it comes back to City Commission for approvals.

Lakemont Ave at Westminster Towers Crosswalk Flashing Ped Signals – The signal construction is complete. Concrete work for ramps is scheduled. Striping to be scheduled.

Bicycle Wayfinding – Adjustments to sign distances and destinations have been re-engineered for the pilot project. Sign updates to be scheduled.

1792 at Morse Blvd Intersection Upgrade – Construction mast arm plans are in final review at FDOT. This project includes new mast arms for the signal and enhanced pedestrian crosswalks.

1792 at Canton Ave Emergency Signal – Study is in final review at FDOT.

Cady Way Trail Crossing at Cady Way - Construction for RRFB at bike trail crossing complete.

Cady Way Trail Crossing at Summerfield Road - Construction for RRFB at crossing complete.

Lakemont Ave at Westminster Towers Crosswalk – The City is proceeding to acquire materials for the relocation of the existing crosswalk and construction of the pedestrian crossing signals.

Active Arterial Management (AAM) / Integrated Corridor Management (ICM – This is an ongoing partnership between FDOT, the City of Winter Park, and other adjacent municipalities.

Transit Signal Priority (TSP) – This is an ongoing partnership between FDOT, Lynx, and the City.

Bicycle Wayfinding – Adjustments to sign distances and destinations are being considered.

Scenic Boat Tour ADA Compliant Access – Construction of ramp is complete. Construction handrails in process. Construction of stairs to supplement ramp is in construction.
