

**CITY OF WINTER PARK  
CANVASSING BOARD  
MARCH 13, 2007**

The Canvassing Board for the City of Winter Park was scheduled to begin at 4:00 p.m., but a quorum was not reached at that time. The meeting was called to order at 5:45 p.m. upon Commissioner Eckbert's arrival in the office of the Orange County Supervisor of Elections, 119 West Kaley Avenue, Orlando, Florida.

**PRESENT:** Mayor David Strong, Commissioner Douglas Metcalf, Commissioner John Eckbert (arrived at 5:45 p.m.), City Attorney Trippe Cheek, and City Clerk Cynthia S. Bonham.

Absentee ballots were opened by the Canvassing Board and separated, keeping voter secrecy. City Clerk Bonham stated a total of 5 ballots had to be canvassed because of either not being signed or the signature did not match the signature on file at the SOE office. Ms. Bonham provided to the Canvassing Board a list of the previously approved criteria to be used to determine which questionable ballots would be accepted or rejected. A total of 1,736 absentee ballots were voted.

Clerks from each precinct modem'ed in the election results from their respective precinct. The tapes from the precincts containing the results were faxed to the Elections Office for use by the Canvassing Board.

Results from the precincts were read by Ms. Bonham from the faxed copy of the tape received from each tabulator from each polling place. Results were not certified due to provisional ballots that would not be counted until March 19.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:30 p.m. to be reconvened on 3/19/2007 at 12:00 noon due to canvass provisional ballots.

Ten (10) provisional ballots were found not to be acceptable for a total of 17 ballots.

Upon review of the information provided by the City Clerk, a **motion was made by Commissioner Metcalf to accept and certify the election results as presented for the March 13, 2007, General and Referendum Election, seconded by Commissioner Eckbert. Motion carried unanimously.**
