## CITY OF WINTER PARK CANVASSING BOARD MARCH 10, 2015 AND MARCH 12, 2015

The Canvassing Board for the City of Winter Park met at 4:00 p.m. on March 10 at the Orange County Supervisor of Elections Office, 119 W. Kaley Street, Orlando, Florida. City Clerk Cindy Bonham directed the meeting. Robin McKinney was present from our City Attorney's office on March 10 and Attorney Larry Brown attended the March 12 meeting until 5:00 when Thu Pham from his office replaced him.

The Canvassing Board consisted of Commissioner Tom McMacken, City Clerk Cynthia Bonham and Library Director Shawn Shaffer.

The Logic and Accuracy test was conducted as the first order of business. The board reviewed the results performed on the absentee voting machine by the Elections Office personnel, making sure that the counts were accurate after running sample ballots through the machine.

Ms. Bonham advised the board that they would be using the Orange County canvassing criteria as approved at the Commission meeting of February 23, 2015. The Canvassing Board canvassed the absentee ballots that were questionable. Decisions were made as to whether ballots would be accepted or rejected based on the criteria. The Canvassing Board attended the final Logic and Accuracy test before departing for the evening to ensure the machine was properly counting the ballots.

The business of the Canvassing Board concluded around 4:45; the board remained until the election results came in.

On March 12, 2015 the Canvassing Board convened at 2:00 to certify the election results. There were no provisional ballots that the Canvassing Board needed to consider.

After certification, the board conducted the manual audit of precinct 9402 as randomly selected at the March 10 board meeting. The manual concluded there was one ballot that was counted for Greg Seidel because of the way the voter marked the ballot that should have been counted as an under vote.

There was a consensus to accept the election results with the change in the one vote as provided by Clerk Bonham and as verified by precinct tapes and data from early voting and absentee voting.

Steven Leary (Mayor) and Greg Seidel (Seat 1) were declared the winners of the election.

The official election results are attached.
