City Clerk Bonham provided the official election results from the March 9, 2004, Charter Referendum Election as provided by the Orange County Canvassing Board.

The election results were as follows:

Total number of votes in favor of the Charter change regarding borrowing funds to purchase park land: 1.615 54.34%

Total number of votes NOT in favor of the Charter change regarding borrowing funds to purchase park land: 1,357 45.66%

Motion made by Assistant City Manager Randy Knight to certify the election results as provided on the spread sheet and verified by the City Clerk as the official results received from the Orange County Canvassing Board, seconded by Commissioner Storer and carried unanimously with a 3-0 vote (Mayor Marchman, Commissioner Storer and Assistant City Manager Knight).
