MINUTES

The meeting was called to order by Vice-Chair Leonard Feinberg at 4:30 p.m. in the Chapman Room of City Hall. - Art on the Green

Mrs. Battaglia gave an update of steering committee activities. She said that the members have been busy working with Ms. Hayes and the City's communications department staff. They met on June 2nd and talked about collateral pieces, developing a catalog and rat card. She added that the first press release went on June 10th; that the City website will have an icon to direct visitors to the catalog and discovery guide, a media list, and the timing of press releases. She added that they met with Kristi Ashby from the local magazines Orange Appeal and Interior Appeal who are interested in doing an article on the exhibit. Mrs. Newberg announced that the sponsor party is scheduled for December 3rd at Luma on Park Avenue. In addition, Ms. Hayes stated that she has located the didactic stands from previous exhibits. Mrs. Newberg is scheduled to go before the Parks

and Recreation Advisory Board and give update on AOG and Mrs. Clanton is scheduled to go before the City Commission to provide an update.
