## Virtual Meeting

### Action Items

Single Use Policy- The City's sustainability division presented the board with a Single Use Policy that has been implemented in Orange County. Some of the products prohibited by this policy would be the use of plastic bags, Styrofoam cups, and straws. After discussion and questions regarding the exemptions of events 75 people or less ***motion made by Jennifer Adams to approve the policy as presented; seconded by Frank Baker. The motion carried with Michael Perelman voting no.***

Phelps Park Playground Selection- Staff and Audra Bussey with Kompan Playgrounds presented the Phelps Park Playground selection, the results of the survey. After budget, landscaping and time line discussion, ***motion made by Drew Nasrallah to approve Phelps playground selection; seconded by Michael Perelman; the motion carried unanimously.***

Lake Knowles Aquatic Plant & Access Management Plan- Staff presented the board with a management plan to allow safe access to the lake/shoreline for recreation activities. Board members had concerns with parking, and abuse of the public beach use; members of the board also inquired about possible landscaping enhancements surrounding the lake. After discussion ***motion made by Brian Furey to approve the management plan as presented; seconded by Kelly Price. Motion carried with Michael Perelman and Jennifer Adams voting no.***

### Reports

- Parks and Landscaping Maintenance Update- Champion Circle project is complete; the new PA system has been installed at the stadium. Denning/Orange Ave redesign is almost complete. Fall annuals being planted around the city.
- Recreation Programming Update- Staff update regarding current programming and events taking place in the City, including music and movie in the park and retail row.

- Baseball has restarted, Tennis Leagues have resumed. Rollins Bach Festival will take place at the Winter Park Golf Course this year.
