## ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS

Chairman Thigpen called the meeting to order at 8:03 am.

### Approval of minutes

Motion made by Ms. Hamilton Buss, seconded by Mr. Trauger to approve February 13, 2020, minutes as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Chm Thigpen introduced Brian Flynn, Parsons, Brinkerhoff, for an update on 17-92.

Mr. Flynn presented a PowerPoint presentation including the project footprint, changes to the footprint, location and size of bike lanes, intersection changes, locations for refuge islands, access management changes, curb cut removal and possible pedestrian flyover. Mr. Attaway provided an overview of how the 2002 project developed, the many steps it took to bring it to fruition and how the funding is divided. In response to a question, he commented it would be 3-4 years, after I4 Ultimate is complete, before construction starts. . Mr. Flynn responded to questions.

Mr. Lim reviewed the crash data from MetroPlan for 2017-2018. Mr. Trauger offered to create a City of Winter Park user name for Signal Four. He explained the benefits of having access to Signal 4 analytics.

## SCOOTER

Mr. Stephenson updated the Board on the issue of scooters in the City. He explained that the information provided by Alex, DeYoung, Newt Scooters was inaccurate. A meeting was held between Mr. DeYoung, Mr. Stephenson and the City Attorney. After discussion Newt will not deploy scooters in the City at this time. The City attorney has drafted an ordinance which is still needs to be reviewed by City staff. The Board will have input before it is presented to the City Commission.
