## Regular Meeting Recap | July 8, 2020

### City Manager's Report

- City Manager Randy Knight explained the City Attorney's five-year contract is expiring September 2020. The City Commission approved the extension of the current City Attorney contract for 12 additional months.

### Action Items Requiring Discussion

#### Review draft resolution governing City Commission meetings

- A [draft resolution](#) was presented outlining the rules governing City Commission meetings. This resolution addresses a variety of topics including when meetings shall be held, the agenda process, decorum, communicating with the Commission during meetings, type of votes, and use of video conferencing.
- Numerous items were discussed to be added to and/or removed from the draft resolution. All approved items will be included in the revised draft to be presented at the Wednesday, July 22 City Commission virtual meeting.

#### Discussion of Progress Point

- Staff was directed to refine the scope of work for concept plans for Progress Point. A work session was requested to discuss the greenway plan, federal grant opportunities, and a draft resolution.
