Regular Meeting Recap | July 22, 2020

City Manager's Report

- City Manager was asked to send a letter to the cable and television partners regarding removal of their utilities from the poles on Fairbanks Avenue.
- The Mayor appointed Jeffrey Sievers to the Transportation Advisory Board.

Non-Action Items

- Commissioner Sullivan delivered a "Ready for 100" presentation regarding 100% renewable energy for the city by 2050. This item will be discussed further by the Utility Advisory Board (UAB) and the Keep Winter Park Beautiful & Sustainable Board (KWPB&S). A request was made for the KWPB&S board to present an update of its progress on the Sustainability Plan and also a cost analysis by the UAB for a "Ready for 100" plan. A resolution will be drafted after the review of the boards.

Consent Agenda

- All items were approved.

Action Items Requiring Discussion

Budget Discussion and Tentative Millage Rate

- The tentative millage rate was approved to be set at an increased rate of 4.5623. This is the rate the Property Appraiser will use in preparing the "Notice of Proposed Property Taxes" to all property owners in August 2020. Once the tentative millage rate is set, it may not be exceeded unless an extensive notification to property owners is undertaken. The final millage can be lower than the tentative millage without additional notification requirements. The final millage will be discussed at the two public hearings scheduled for September 9 and 23, 2020.

Public Hearings

- The first reading of the [ordinance](#) declaring and implementing a contingent temporary moratorium as it relates to the Orange Avenue Overlay District was approved.
- The first reading of the [ordinance](#) related to construction and related noise was approved as presented with the removal of the section 62-97(b) titled Waivers for Construction Activities.
- The [resolution](#) governing City Commission meetings was approved with two additions.
