Regular Meeting Recap | August 12, 2020

City Manager's Report

- The Winter Park Chamber of Commerce presented an economic impact study conducted by the Balmoral Group and commissioned by THRIVE, a Winter Park organization developed to assist in the recovery of COVID-19. The City Commission authorized a staff liaison to work with the Chamber on recovery efforts as discussed, with any city financial requests coming forward when/if needed.

Consent Agenda

- All items were approved.

Action Items Requiring Discussion

- The purchase of 2410 Winter Park Road for [stormwater purposes](#) was approved.

Public Hearings

- The second reading of the [ordinance](#) related to construction and related noise was approved as presented.
- The second reading of the [ordinance](#) declaring and implementing a contingent temporary moratorium as it relates to the Orange Avenue Overlay District was approved.
- The first reading of the [ordinance](#) to adopt the Orange County Fertilizer Regulations was approved with an amendment. The City Commission asked staff to work on an educational campaign regarding these regulations.
- The request for [voluntary annexation](#) of seven properties on Kentucky Avenue was tabled and a work session was requested to discuss this topic.

Commission Reports

The following items were discussed or asked to be placed on future City Commission agendas for discussion:

- All city advisory board meetings will continue to be conducted virtually until further notice.
- A work session will be scheduled regarding the Fiscal Year 2021 budget.

- The City Commission Work Session regarding the [Orange Avenue Overlay](#) is scheduled for Thursday, August 13, at 1 p.m.
- A discussion regarding the voting policies for street bricking and other assessment programs was held and will be scheduled for a future agenda.
- The City Manager gave an update regarding the post office property status and Commissioner Cooper was approved as the Commission Designate to work with staff on this effort.
- A discussion regarding single member districts was held and will be placed on a future agenda.
