Regular Meeting Recap | March 24, 2021

Oath of Office

- Mayor Phil Anderson was officially sworn-in as the 55th Mayor of the City of Winter Park. His wife Jennifer provided the Oath of Office and was joined by a small group of family, residents and city officials.

City Manager Report

- A virtual work session has been scheduled for **Tuesday, March 30, 10 a.m.**, to discuss Commissioner priorities.

Consent Agenda

- All items were approved with amendments made to the minutes.

Action Items Requiring Discussion

- [Killarney Roadway Network Improvements](#) were discussed and the following items were approved: Option #1 proposal, funding source for the parklet to come from the Park Acquisition Funds and reimbursement to the developer for the bollards. This will be discussed further at a City Commission Work Session.
- [Additional parking](#) was discussed for Martin Luther King, Jr. Park and the new Winter Park Library & Events Center. It was decided to delete the Harper Street parking option and staff will provide information as it relates to parking needs at the site.

Public Hearings

- The [request of the City of Winter Park](#) for a Fee Schedule amendment, resolution and joint participating agreement as it relates to affordable housing was approved with an amendment.
- The request of [Lake Spier Development LLC](#) for Conditional Use approval to allow for the development of 10 two-story townhouses on the 1.28 acres at 1915 S. Lakemont Ave. was approved with amendments.
- The first reading of the [ordinance](#) requested by the City of Winter Park to establish regulations regarding artificial turf was approved with an amendment.
- The second reading of the [ordinance](#) to vacate the easement at 1020 Bonita Drive was approved.

City Commission Reports

- Staff was directed to:
 - schedule a final report presentation from the Economic Recovery Task Force.
 - schedule a joint work session with Planning & Zoning and City Commission regarding the Orange Avenue Overlay project.
 - assess the city improvements needed for Killarney neighborhood.
 - review traffic on Palmer Avenue.
 - explore moving Commission meetings back to the Commission Chambers in City Hall. A decision of this will be made at a future meeting.
