Election of Vice-Mayor

Commissioner Carolyn Cooper was nominated and approved to continue her role as Vice Mayor.

Consent Agenda

All items were approved with amendments made to the work session minutes of March 30.

Action Items Requiring Discussion

- The parking area of the Library & Events Center/MLK, Jr. Park was discussed and city staff will present the various options for the Commission's consideration.
- It was approved to move City Commission meetings back to the Commission Chambers beginning June 1, subject to Commission review as the date nears.
- A discussion was held regarding the renewal of advisory boards. The advisory boards listed in the agenda packet were approved for renewal, with exception to the Golf Advisory Board that was approved to be sunsetted. The Parks & Recreation Advisory Board will address any items related to the golf course going forward. Modifications to other boards were discussed and may come forward at future Commission meetings. Staff was requested to bring forward a draft ordinance to consider the establishment of an Orange Avenue Overlay Appearance Review Board.

Public Hearings

• The request of the City of Winter Park for an ordinance to establish regulations regarding artificial turf was postponed to the April 28 City Commission meeting.

 - To develop a Request for Proposal (RFP) for a consultant to create an urban planning-type process focusing on neighborhood village scale and character.
 - Consider the creation of a task force to focus on diversity, equity and inclusion.
