## Regular Meeting Recap | May 26, 2021

### Mayor's Report

### City Manager's Report

- It was confirmed to [move City Commission meetings back to the Commission Chambers](#) located on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of City Hall (401 S. Park Ave.) starting with the Wednesday, June 9 City Commission meeting.

### Non-Action Items

- The [board appointment](#) to the Parks & Recreation Advisory Board was presented.

### Consent Agenda

- All items were approved with modifications to the minutes of the May 13 City Commission Work Session.

### Action Items Requiring Discussion

- The [American Rescue Plan Act \(ARPA\) Funding Non-Profit Support Program](#) was presented and the agenda item was tabled to the Wednesday, June 9 City Commission meeting. A sub-committee of the City Commission will work with staff to further evaluate the application criteria and process prior to making recommendations to the City Commission.

### Public Hearings

- The [request of A&R Real Estate Development](#) for subdivision approval to split the properties platted as Lots 25 & 26 on Loch Lomond Drive was approved. The first reading of the ordinance related to a request of the city to change the Future Land Use designation on Lots 25-27 from Office to Single Family Residential, was approved.
- The [resolution](#) to designate 827 W. Lyman Ave. as a historic property, was approved.
- The second reading of the [ordinance](#) amending Article III, Chapter 2 of the City of Winter Park Code of Ordinance regarding subsidiary city boards, was approved.
