## Regular Meeting Recap | July 14, 2021

### City Manager's Report

- City Manager Randy Knight presented the city's Fiscal Year 2021/22 proposed budget and 5-Year Capital Plan. Located within this presentation is an outline of the budget approval process schedule that allows for citizen comments about the budget during each regular City Commission meeting beginning in July through final approval in September.

### Non-Action Items

- Commissioner Todd Weaver made his appointment to the Civil Service Board.

### Consent Agenda

- All items were approved with modifications to the City Commission June 24 meeting minutes.

### Action Items Requiring Discussion

- The City Commission approved the engagement of a Federal lobbyist with an amendment.
- The request to re-establish the Lake Killarney Advisory Board was tabled.
- The staff recommendation for the Rollins College Softball Stadium improvements was conceptually approved with an amendment as it relates to the facility use agreement.
- Discussion was held regarding Progress Point Park. The City Commission approved the realignment of Palmetto Avenue and the budget projections as presented by city staff with amendments.

### Public Hearings

- The first reading of the ordinance providing for the annexation of approximately 0.8 +/- acres of real property located at 647/653 Harold Ave. and a portion of the adjacent Harold Avenue right of way was approved.
- The first reading of the ordinance authorizing Orange County Air Quality Monitoring Building relocation and lease was approved.
- The second reading of the ordinance establishing a Broadband and smart city Ad-Hoc Committee was tabled until the July 28 City Commission meeting.
