## Regular Meeting Recap | August 25, 2021

### Mayor's Report

- Mayor Phil Anderson reinforced the request to all [Winter Park water utility customers to conserve water](#) for the next few weeks. The urgency is due to the shortage of liquid oxygen being experienced by the surge of COVID-19 treatments. Liquid oxygen is an essential component of the ozone gas used by the department to purify the water. If enough water is not conserved during this critical time, system-wide boil water alerts may need to be issued before water can be used for cooking or drinking. All water utility customers are asked to reduce water usage by not washing cars and to delay the use of pressure washers. In addition, customers that use potable water for irrigation are requested to minimize the frequency of watering their lawns.

### Consent Agenda

- All items were approved with modifications to the August 10 City Commission work session and August 11 regular meeting minutes.

### Action Items Requiring Discussion

- The appointment to the [Winter Park Police Officers' Pension Board](#) and [Civil Service Board](#) was made.
- The [reallocated Strategic Capital Plan](#) was discussed and the Commission agreed to the list with modifications.
- The [Fiscal Year 2022 budget](#) was discussed and each [Commissioner's suggestions](#) were reviewed. There were several budget worksheet items that were approved that will be reflected in the budget ordinance at the next City Commission meeting.
- [Reconsideration](#) was given regarding the Notice of Disposal (NOD) of the Swoope property located at 631 N. New York Ave. and it was approved with an amendment.
- The creation of the [Lake Killarney Advisory Board](#) was approved.
- [Public solicitation for land to construct U.S. Postal Service facilities](#) was approved. Staff was authorized to draft a request for interest with a 60-day limit.

### Public Hearings

- The [second readings of the ordinances](#) related to the request of the City of Winter Park related to properties on Loch Lomond Drive were approved.

- The [request of Wooten Built, Inc.](#) for subdivision approval to split the property at 280 E. Lake Sue Ave., was approved.
- The [first reading of the ordinance](#) related to the City of Winter Park's request related to 647/653 Harold Ave. was approved.
- The [first reading of the ordinance](#) amending the Historic Preservation Code and resolution of the Historic Preservation Board was tabled to the Wednesday, September 8 City Commission meeting.
- The [first reading of the ordinance](#) to amend the Comprehensive Plan to adopt a new private property rights element in accordance with State Statutes was approved with an amendment.
- The [first reading of the ordinance](#) proposing charter amendments for the March 2022 ballot was tabled to the Wednesday, September 8 City Commission meeting.
