City Manager's Report

- A special presentation was made to George Wiggins honoring his 47 years of service and congratulating him on his upcoming retirement.
- A [report](#) was given regarding the employee voluntary vaccination program.

Millage and Budget Public Hearings

- The second reading of the [ordinance](#) adopting millage rates for the Fiscal Year 2022 budget was approved.
- The second reading of the [ordinance](#) adopting the Fiscal Year 2022 budget was approved.

Public Hearings

- The second reading of the [ordinance](#) amending the Historic Preservation Code and resolution of the Historic Preservation Board was approved.
- The first reading of the [ordinance](#) proposing Charter Amendments for the March 2022 ballot was approved with amendments.
- The second reading of the [ordinance](#) amending Subsidiary City Boards and Lake Killarney Advisory Board was approved and appointments will be made at next City Commission meeting.
- The first reading of the [ordinance](#) approving amendment to Line of Credit with Truist for Electric was approved.
- The first reading of the [ordinance](#) amending the Comprehensive Plan to create the Orange Avenue Overlay (OAO) District was approved with amendments.

City Commission Reports

- Staff was asked to schedule a work session to discuss the plans for the replacement of the Spray Ground at Shady Park and also the plans for the development of the Martin Luther King,

Jr. Park Unity Corner. In addition, it was requested to explore city parks and greenways as part of a strategic plan discussion to identify city park needs that may benefit from grant funding opportunities.

- At the October 14 work session, staff was asked to arrange for proposers of “The Exchange” concept to make a presentation at that meeting.
