

Regular Meeting Recap | October 13, 2021

Mayor's Report

• A presentation by Florida City County Management Association was made recognizing the city's 70th anniversary of adopting the commission/city manager form of government.

City Manager's Report

• Staff will schedule a joint work session with the City Commission and Planning & Zoning Board to discuss the vision for the redevelopment of properties east of Interstate 4 and south of Fairbanks Avenue.

City Attorney's Report

• A request was made by Demetree/Holler for a meeting regarding the Orange Avenue Overlay and the city will ask for relevant information to be sent to staff.

Non-Action Items

• The report of appointments to the Lake Killarney Advisory Board was given and will be resolved at the next City Commission meeting.

Consent Agenda

Action Items Requiring Discussion

- The Tanglewood Canal Interlocal Agreement was approved.
- The proposal to increase minimum wage for full-time positions to \$15 was approved.

Public Hearings

- The resolution and request of Kent McKee to designate the property at 1115 N. Kentucky Ave. to the Winter Park Register of Historic Places was approved.
- The resolution and request by Jason and Tammi Shapiro to designate the property at 1565 Orange Ave. built in 1926 to the Winter Park Register of Historic Places was approved. The request of Ron Scarpa for subdivision approval to split the property at 1832 Pineview Circle was approved with conditions.
- The first reading of the ordinance authorizing the Lease and Operating & Funding Agreement with the Winter Park Public Library was approved.

- The second reading of the ordinance adopting a new Comprehensive Plan Element for Private Property Rights pursuant to State Statute was approved with amendments.
- The second reading of the ordinance proposing Charter Amendments for the March 2022 ballot was approved.
- The second reading of the ordinance approving amendment to Line of Credit with Truist for electric was approved.

City Commission Reports

- The Winter Park Public Library is an early voting site and staff was asked to work on guidelines for election sign placement.
- Staff will schedule future meetings to discuss the following topics:
