Regular Meeting Recap | January 26, 2022

Mayor’s Report

- Reminded residents to vote in the March 8, 2022 Election. Information regarding the election can be accessed at cityofwinterpark.org/elections.
- The city accepted a donation of \$30,000 from Mike and Gail Winn to erect a historic clock that will be installed adjacent to Central Park at the intersection of Park and Welbourne avenues.
- The [work session](#) scheduled for Thursday, January 27, at 1 p.m. was cancelled.

City Manager’s Report

- City Manager Randy Knight announced Winter Park Police Chief Michael Deal resigned, effective January 26, 2022. The city will begin the process of filling the Police Chief position as soon as possible. Division Chief Pam Marcum will continue to serve as acting Police Chief until further notice.
- The city’s Town Hall Meeting featuring the Mayor’s State of the City Address has been scheduled for Sunday, February 27, 2022, from 2 to 3 p.m. This event will be held at the Winter Park Events Center Ballroom located at 1050 W. Morse Blvd. Additional information will be posted on cityofwinterpark.org as details are confirmed.

Consent Agenda

- All items were approved with modifications to the minutes for the January 12 City Commission meeting and ARPA funding allocations.

Action Items Requiring Discussion

- The [Federal legislative funding priorities](#) were approved.
- The [Historic Preservation Board](#) and staff were approved to launch their [Historic Landmark Sign Program](#).
- The City Commission approved staff to move forward with the contract to acquire the [Winter Pines Golf Course](#). A committee will be formed to assist in the transition.

Public Hearings

- The [resolution](#) designating City Hall building to the Winter Park Register of Historic Places was approved.

- The second reading of the [ordinance](#) amending Chapter 114, modifying shoreline revetment slope requirement from 3:1 to 2:1 was approved.
- The request of Z Properties for approval to grant an easement located behind 341 N. Pennsylvania Ave. was approved to be continued to Wednesday, February 9.

City Commission Reports

- A discussion will be scheduled regarding non-profit rental rates at the Winter Park Events Center.
- Request was made for staff to include a spreadsheet/chart outlining details associated with zoning changes as part of the application review process.
