Non-Action Items

Consent Agenda

- All items were approved.

Action Items Requiring Discussion

- The [Swoope Property Notice-To-Dispose \(NOD\)](#) responses were discussed and staff was approved to move forward to negotiate with both parties that submitted proposals.
- The Commission requested a review of the fee structure as it relates to [discounts to standard rates for city rental venues](#). A new discounted rental rate was approved for Winter Park-based non-profits to rent the Winter Park Events Center following specific criteria.

Public Hearings

- The requests of 3217 Corrine, LLC for approval of the second reading of the [ordinances](#) regarding 3303 and 3313 Corrine Drive and 1813 Northwood Terrace Drive were approved as presented.
- The requests of RSRW Properties, LLC for approval of the first reading of the [ordinances](#) related to 1471 Harmon Avenue were approved.
- The first reading of the [ordinance](#) authorizing conveyance of property at 654 Selkirk Drive was approved.
- The [request of Z Properties](#) for approval to grant an easement located behind 341 N. Pennsylvania Ave. was approved to be continued to Wednesday, February 23.
