## Regular Meeting Recap | February 23, 2022

### Mayor's Report

- The Winter Park Police & Fire-Rescue Departments recognized [Don Palladeno](#) for his service to each agency.

### City Manager Report

- Division Chief [Timothy R. Volkerson](#) was confirmed as the new Chief of Police for the Winter Park Police Department.

### City Attorney Report

- The [Declaration of Restrictive Covenant - West Meadow](#) was tabled.

### Consent Agenda

- All items were approved.

### Action Items Requiring Discussion

- The [request of Utility Advisory Board \(UAB\) to hire a consultant to address governance](#) was discussed and determined a strategic planning session is the recommended course of action.
- The [appeal of Tree Permit Denial](#) for 1417 Border Drive was denied.
- It was confirmed that the weekly [COVID-19](#) testing for employees will be discontinued Monday, February 28, 2022, and all city advisory board meetings will resume in-person meetings beginning Friday, April 1.
- [Winter Park High School's request](#) to use the parking lots at City Hall and Farmers' Market for a fundraiser during the Winter Park Sidewalk Art Festival was approved.
