## Regular Meeting Recap | April 27, 2022

### Mayor's Report

- May was proclaimed as Historic Preservation Month celebrating the city's history and the efforts of the Historic Preservation Board in safeguarding our city's historic homes and districts. - The city is scheduled to close on the Winter Pines Golf Course Friday, April 29.

### Non-Action Items

- Commissioner Kris Cruzada and Vice Mayor Todd Weaver made their [board appointments](#).

### Consent Agenda

- All items were approved.

### Action Items Requiring Discussion

- [Commission Board Appointments](#) were made to the Winter Park Firefighters' Pension Board, Police Officers' Pension Board and Winter Park Housing Authority.
- Each of the [Citizen Advisory Boards](#) were reviewed and the Commission confirmed several responsibilities. Staff will summarize and provide additional board standards and processes.
- [Hybrid board meetings](#) were discussed and city staff's proposal was approved. This proposal will offer live streaming for all meetings, equipping the Ray Beary Room at the Public Safety Facility with audio and video equipment, and the hiring of an additional IT staff member to support these services.

### Public Hearings

- The [requests](#) of Winter Park Town Center Ltd. (Winter Park Village) for Conditional Use approval to install three electronic signs on the front façade of Regal Cinemas, were denied.
- The [request](#) of Creative Neighbors LLC to approve the Comprehensive Development Plan for the PURD zoning on the rear 5.38 acres of 740/760 N. Lakemont Ave., was approved.
- The [resolution](#) in opposition to land use changes at 2300 S. Semoran Blvd., was approved.

## City Commission Reports

- Request was made for staff and the Transportation Advisory Board to explore what needs that can benefit from the Orange County penny sales tax, if approved.
- Staff will notify merchants that the curbside pick-up zones in Downtown Winter Park will be removed on Wednesday, June 1.
- A work session will be scheduled to discuss the Community Redevelopment Agency expansion/extension.
