Regular Meeting Recap | March 8, 2023

Mayor's Report

- Two proclamations were presented in recognition for Irish-American Heritage Month and Education & Sharing Day.
- Climate First Bank was recognized with a [Green Business Award](#) at the Platinum level. This award acknowledges their efforts to lower their carbon footprint, promote electrification and further their sustainability efforts.

City Manager's Report

- The City Manager announced the city received a Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) Grant of not to exceed \$3.3 million for storm-hardening projects such as the Lake Bell Weir, Howell Creek debris removal, 9th Grade Center Pond repairs, major outfall sediment removal, Lake Killarney Cove sediment removal, Howell Creek bank stabilization, and Winter Pines ditch and pond dredging.

Public Hearings: Quasi-Judicial Matters

- The first reading of the [ordinance](#) to vacate the western 15 feet of Via Tuscany right-of-way located at 2433 Via Tuscany was approved.

Public Hearings: Non-Quasi-Judicial Matters

- The second reading of the [ordinance](#) 3261-23: Updating Section 58-87, lakefront and waterfront zoning regulations to update the regulations concerning construction on waterfront lots and as pursuant to the review by the planning and zoning board, was approved.
- The second reading of the [ordinance](#) amending Chapter 58, "Land Development Code", Article III, "Zoning" Section 58-95 "Definitions" and Article V, "Environmental Protection Regulations" Division 1, "Stormwater Management" adding regulations governing artificial turf installations and maintenance of artificial turf, was approved with an amendment.
