### Public Hearings: Non-Quasi Judicial Matters

- The second reading of the [ordinance](#) amending Chapter 58, "Land Development Code", Article III, "Zoning Regulations" Section 58-87 and amending Chapter 114 "Waterways" to update the regulations concerning docks and boathouses, was approved.
- The second reading of the [ordinances](#) relating to approximately 2.07 acres of real property at 1896; 1934; 1964; 1968; 1970 and 1990 Kentucky Avenue, were approved.
- [Resolution 2272-23](#) affirming changes to the 2024 General Election during the Presidential Preference Primary, was approved.
