Regular Meeting Recap | September 13, 2023

Mayor's Report

- The [appointment](#) to Winter Park Housing Authority Board was approved.

City Manager Report

- The Commission meeting [schedule](#) was approved with minor changes.
- Parsram Rajaram provided an update on the city's [Smart City](#) efforts as requested by the Commission.

Non-Action Items

- Margaret Bohl was [appointed](#) to the Public Art Advisory Board.

Consent Agenda

- All items were approved.

Millage Rate and Public Hearings

- First reading of the [ordinance](#) adopting millage rates for the FY 2024 budget was approved.
- First reading of the [ordinance](#) adopting the FY 2024 budget was approved with an amendment.
- Commission approved city staff to make an offer to purchase the Bank of the Ozarks property.

Public Hearings: Non-Quasi-Judicial Matters

- [Resolution 2279-23](#) - adopting stormwater assessment roll was approved. Appeals to the stormwater assessment fees can be made by accessing the [appeal form](#) located on the city website at cityofwinterpark.org/departments/public-works-transportation/stormwater.
- The [fee schedule](#) was approved and will be effective October 1, 2023.
- The first reading of the [ordinance](#) amending Chapter 58, "Land Development Code," Article V to address the discharge and disposition of cooling water from buildings adjacent to Center Street, was approved.
- The first reading of the [ordinance](#) extending franchise agreement for Waste Pro of Florida, Inc., was approved.

- The [second reading of the ordinance](#) amending Chapter 58, “Land Development Code”, Article III, “Zoning” Section 58-71 “General provisions for residential zoning districts”, to revise subsection (f) regarding the parking of boats, trailers and recreation vehicles to include vehicles over 25 feet, was approved.
- The [second reading of the ordinance](#) amending Chapter 2, Article V, Departments, creating new departments, renaming departments and updating department functions and responsibilities, was approved.

City Commission Reports

- Commission provided guidance to staff regarding board members with attendance issues and notification procedures.
- Staff was requested to evaluate the cargo doors and lighting at the Winter Park Farmers’ Market.
