- First reading of the ordinance adopting millage rates for the FY 2024 budget was approved.
- First reading of the ordinance adopting the FY 2024 budget was approved with an amendment.
- Commission approved city staff to make an offer to purchase the Bank of the Ozarks property.

Public Hearings: Non-Quasi-Judicial Matters
