Action Items Requiring Discussion

- The City Commission approved the [adoption](#) of a tentative millage rate of 4.0923 mills and a voted debt service millage of 0.2207 required to service debt on the General Obligation Bonds, Series 2017 & 2020 (Library and Events Center Bonds).

Public Hearings: Quasi-Judicial Matters

- The [request of William Keegan](#) for subdivision approval to split the properties at 1760 and 1780 Bryan Avenue into three single-family lots, zoned R-1A, was approved.

Public Hearings: Non Quasi-Judicial Matters

- The [first reading of the ordinance](#) amending Chapter 10 "Alcoholic Beverages" Section 10-33 "hours during which sales, consumption and service are prohibited" so as to establish uniform hours of sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages, was approved.
