Millage Rate and Budget Public Hearing

- The second reading of the ordinance adopting millage rates for FY 2025 budget was approved for an operating millage rate at 4.0923 mills and debt service millage rate at 0.2207 for the General Obligation Bonds (Library/Events Center), Series 2017 & 2020.
- The second reading of the ordinance adopting the FY 2025 budget and 5-Year Capital Plan was approved.

Public Hearings: Quasi-Judicial Matters

- The Fee Schedule to be effective October 1, 2024, was approved.
- The first reading of the ordinance regarding a request of the City to amend Chapter 58, "Land Development Code", Article III, "Zoning" Section 58-72 Office (O-1) District to revise the criteria for conditional uses for restaurants, cafes, coffee shops and other food establishments, was approved.
- The first reading of the ordinance regarding a request of the City to amend Chapter 58 "Land Development Code", Article III, "Zoning Regulations" Subsection 58-86 "Off-Street Parking and Loading Regulations" so as to modify the multi-family residential, retail, office and restaurant parking regulations within the city, was approved.

 - An Agreement to provide for vesting of rights for properties zoned R-4, under the 2017 Comprehensive Plan, was approved.

City Commission Report

- Staff was asked to prepare an ordinance to allow the Tree Preservation Board to sunset and treerelated hearings be brought to the Code Compliance Board.
- A request was made for staff to develop guidelines for non-profits to request funding.
