Mayor’s Report

- The Mayor shared appreciation to city staff, the Park Avenue District and the Winter Park Chamber of Commerce for all of the hard work related to the recent [holiday events](#).

City Manager’s Report

- The City Manager will prepare resolution proposing revised language related to the leaf blower ballot question for the Commission’s approval.
- Hal George, Chair of the Winter Park Housing Authority, introduced the authority’s new Executive Director, Tarena Grant.
- There were a few minor changes to the previously approved [Joint Planning agreement](#) between the city and Orange County. These changes were approved by the Commission.

Non-action items

- A red light camera [report](#) was presented by Winter Park Police Chief Tim Volkerson.

Consent Agenda

- All items were approved with exception to one item withdrawn by staff.

Action Items Requiring Discussion

- The [basin studies](#) recommendations and first group of projects were presented and approved.
- 2025 [State Legislative Priorities](#) were approved.
- The [transfer of property](#) located at 1401 Howell Branch Road from the Building Department to the water and electric utilities was tabled to the January 22, 2025 City Commission meeting.

- The proposed [Sponsorship and Advertising Policy](#) as it relates to city parks was tabled.

Public Hearings: Non-Quasi-Judicial Matters

- [Resolution 2293-24](#), amending Resolution 1552 (classifications of groups of employees for city contribution rates to the 457 deferred compensation plan), was approved.
- The [ordinance](#) amending Section 6 of Ordinance 3292-24 to allow for mail in referendum on leaf blowing in the event that the general city election to be held on March 11, 2025, is not needed for the election of commissioners, was approved.
