- The Executive Director Betsy Owens and Chairperson John Bill of Casa Feliz Historic Home & Museum, one of the city's [Arts & Culture Alliance](#) members, offered an update and presentation.

Mayor's Report

- Sheila Rankin, CEO of AdventHealth Winter Park, was introduced and welcomed by the City Commission.
- Betsy Gardner, CEO of the Winter Park Chamber of Commerce, gave a presentation regarding upcoming events.
- State Representative David Smith shared a check presentation for:
 - A matching grant of \$62,500 for vehicle threat mitigation that will help our police department purchase security barriers to keep our large gathering spaces safe.
 - A half a million dollars (\$500k) to help support the replacement of Stirling Bridge located south of Lake Virginia.
