Public Hearings Quasi-Judicial Matters

- The [reconsideration](#) of: SUB #26-02. Z Properties request for subdivision approval, to divide the property at 436 North Knowles Avenue, zoned R-3, into two single family lots, was approved with conditions.
- [Second reading of the ordinance](#) amending Chapter 58, "Land Development Code", Article III, "Zoning" Section 58-79 "Public and Quasi-Public (PQP) District", to add a new permitted use for detached single-family dwelling units developed in accordance with the R-1A development standards set forth in Section 58-65(f), was revised and will be scheduled for public hearing at the May 27 City Commission meeting.
