Community Partner Presentation

- An update was given by the Winter Park Chamber of Commerce's new President/CEO Annemarie Cooper.

Mayor's Report

- Senator Jason Brodeur & Representative Anna Eskamani presented \$500K Grant Check to the city's Mead Botanical Garden. This grant is focused on removing the legacy nutrient pollution from Alice's Pond and restore the Winter Park Chain of Lakes' ecological balance.



- The [Summer Youth Enrichment Program](#) FY2026 Participants were recognized.



- A [proclamation](#) was presented in honor of Arbor Day in Winter Park.

Consent Agenda

- All items were approved.

Action Items Requiring Discussion

- [Blue Bamboo Center for the Arts' request](#) to extend code compliance deadline by 33 days, was approved with conditions.

Public Hearings: Quasi-Judicial Matters

- The [request of the Summer Time Management, LLC](#), to Annex the Property at 915 North Wymore Road and establish Commercial Future Land Use and Commercial (C-3) Zoning on the annexed property, was approved.
- The [request of GAI Consultants, Inc.](#), for Conditional Use approval for the property located at 210 E. Morse Boulevard, on behalf of El Cortez, LTD (property owner), in conjunction with Chabad of Greater Orlando, for a project consisting of five townhome units fronting Morse Boulevard, which will be two stories in height plus partially below-level basement garages for parking; and a three-story synagogue building fronting Knowles Avenue, including an underground parking garage, a place of worship with rooftop deck for associated functions, and a daycare facility, was approved at first reading.

Public Hearings: Non-Quasi-Judicial Matters

- The [second reading](#) of the request of Tara Tedrow for an Ordinance amending Chapter 58 "Land Development Code" Article, I, "Comprehensive Plan" so as to add a new policy within the text of the Future Land Use Element to permit the subdivision or lot split of lakefront property that meets specific criteria, was tabled until October 14, 2026.
