Community Partner Presentation

- An update was given by the Winter Park Benefit Shop.

Mayor's Report

- A [proclamation](#) was presented recognizing Drive Electric Month.

City Manager's Report

- The [Fiscal Year Quarter 1](#) meeting schedule was approved with a revision.

Consent Agenda

- All items were approved with an amendment.

Action Items Requiring Discussion

- The [Paid Parking Pilot program](#) for Dinky Dock and Lake Baldwin Park was approved.

Millage Rate and Budget Public Hearing

- First reading of the [ordinance](#) adopting a FY 2027 operating millage rate at 4.0923 mills and debt service millage rate at 0.1937 for General Obligation Bonds (Library/Events Center), Series 2017 & 2020, was approved.
- First reading of the [ordinance](#) adopting the FY 2027 budget with a modification.

Public Hearings: Quasi-Judicial Matters

- The second reading of the [request of the Summer Time Management, LLC](#), to Annex the Property at 915 North Wymore Road and establish Commercial Future Land Use and Commercial (C-3) Zoning on the annexed property, was approved.

- The second reading of the [request of GAI Consultants, Inc.](#), for Conditional Use approval for the property located at 210 E. Morse Boulevard, on behalf of El Cortez, LTD (property owner), in conjunction with Chabad of Greater Orlando, for a project consisting of five townhome units fronting Morse Boulevard, which will be two stories in height plus partially below-level basement garages for parking; and a three-story synagogue building fronting Knowles Avenue, including an underground parking garage, a place of worship with rooftop deck for associated functions, and a daycare facility, was tabled to October 28.

Public Hearings: Non-Quasi-Judicial Matters

- The first reading of the [ordinance](#) regarding water and wastewater rate adjustments, was approved.
- [Resolution 2312-26](#) adopting changes to city Fee Schedule other than water and wastewater rates was approved with amendments.
- [Resolution 2313-26](#) Advocating for Expanded Use of Tourist Development Taxes, was approved.
- The first reading of the micromobility [ordinance](#), was approved.
