## Regular Meeting Recap | September 9, 2020

### City Manager's Report

- The City Commission supported having monthly recurring work sessions that will be scheduled on the second Thursday of each month.

### Non-Action Items

- A presentation regarding the city's [Financial Report for July 31, 2020](#) was given by Finance Director Wes Hamil.

### Consent Agenda

- All items were approved with amendments made to the City Commission's Regular & Work Session meeting minutes.

### Public Hearings

- The [resolution designating 1366 Devon Road as a historic property](#) on the Winter Park Register of Historic Places was approved.
- The second reading of the [ordinance establishing regulations to backyard chickens](#) as a pilot program was approved with amendments.
- The first reading of the [ordinance requesting voluntary annexation](#) of seven properties on Kentucky Avenue was tabled.
- The [fee schedule](#) was approved as presented.

### Millage and Budget Public Hearings

- The first reading of the [ordinance adopting the FY 2021 Millage Rates](#) was approved as presented. The operating millage rate was approved at 4.0923 mills (the same millage for the past 12 years) and debt service millage at 0.1263.
- The first reading of the ordinance [adopting the FY 2021 Budget & Capital Plan](#) was approved with one amendment.

### Commission Reports

The following items were discussed or asked to be placed on future City Commission agendas for discussion:

- Staff to coordinate an electric landscape equipment demonstration.

- Utility Advisory Board to consider a fuel rate holiday.
- Request for staff to obtain City Commission approval before any notice of the public hearings for the Orange Avenue Overlay (OAO) project is publicized. The Commission also agreed to work from the January OAO document going forward.
