Regular Meeting Recap | September 23, 2020

City Manager's Report

- A presentation regarding the parking code and impact fee for the Central Business District was given. No decision was made at this time.
- A work session to discuss single member districts will be scheduled for Thursday, October 8, and an annexation work session will be scheduled.

Consent Agenda

- All items were approved.

Action Items Requiring Discussion

- A presentation was given regarding the Economic Recovery Task Force efforts in partnership with the City of Winter Park. A Community Redevelopment Agency meeting will be scheduled to discuss City Manager funding approval amounts. Plans for safe gatherings and a mask wearing campaign will continue until funding limits have been approved.
- The [realignment of Bennett Avenue & Executive Drive](#) at Lee Road was discussed and tabled.

Millage and Budget Public Hearings

- The second reading of the [ordinance adopting the FY 2021 Millage Rates](#) was approved. The operating millage rate was approved at 4.0923 mills and debt service millage rate at 0.1263 for the General Obligation Bonds, Series 2011, and 0.3025 for the General Obligation Bonds (Library/Events Center), Series 2017 & 2020.
- The second reading of the ordinance [adopting the FY 2021 Budget & Capital Plan](#) was approved.

Public Hearings

- The first reading of the request of the City of Winter Park for an [ordinance](#) to adopt regulations to regulate the amount of fill added to residential lots was approved.
- The request of the City of Winter Park for an [ordinance](#) amending Article IV "Subdivision and Lot Consolidation Regulations" was approved with an amendment.
- The [request of Interlachen North Partners, LLC](#): Extension of the Conditional Use approval at 503 N. Interlachen Ave., was automatically extended due to multiple Governor Executive Orders pursuant to Section 252.363(1)(a), Florida Statutes.
