City Manager’s Report

- The city’s new and expanded [holiday decorations](#) design plan was approved. Beginning Saturday, November 20, downtown Winter Park will be decorated to bring to life a “Hometown Holidays” theme throughout downtown including Park Avenue, Morse Boulevard, New England Avenue, Orange Avenue, and the following parks Central, Shady and Martin Luther King, Jr., for all to enjoy the holiday season.

- The first reading of the [ordinance](#) adopting millage rates for the Fiscal Year 2022 budget was approved.
- The first reading of the [ordinance](#) adopting the Fiscal Year 2022 budget was approved with amendments.

Public Hearings

- The [second reading of the ordinance](#) related to the City of Winter Park’s request related to 647/653 Harold Ave. was approved.
- The [first reading of the ordinance](#) amending the Historic Preservation Code and resolution of the Historic Preservation Board was approved with an amendment.

- The first reading of the [ordinance](#) proposing Charter Amendments for the March 2022 ballot was tabled until the next meeting.
- The first reading of the [ordinance](#) amending Subsidiary City Boards and Lake Killarney Advisory Board was approved with amendments.
- The [fee schedule](#) effective October 1, 2021 was approved.
