

ORDINANCE NO. 2674-06

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WINTER PARK, FLORIDA  
AMENDING SECTION 2-102 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF  
THE CITY OF WINTER PARK TO PROVIDE FOR AN EIGHTH  
ALTERNATE MEMBER OF THE CODE ENFORCEMENT BOARD;  
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**BE IT ENACTED** by the people of the City of Winter Park, Florida as follows:

**Section 1.** Section 2-102(a) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Winter Park, Florida is hereby amended to read as follows:

*Sec. 2-102. Board created; composition; terms; removal; organization.*

(a) There is created a code enforcement board of the city which shall consist of seven members and an eighth alternate member appointed by the mayor subject to confirmation by the city commission. All members shall be residents of the city and shall serve without compensation.

The alternate eighth member shall be so designated as an alternate to the board, and shall participate in and vote upon such matters coming before the board only in the event a regular member is absent from the meeting or declares a conflict of interest and abstains from voting on a particular matter. The alternate member shall possess the same qualifications as a regular member, and shall be appointed pursuant to the same procedure as appointment of a regular member.


**Section 2.** This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
