

ORDINANCE 3342-25

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WINTER PARK, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 58, "LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE", ARTICLE III, "ZONING" AND THE OFFICIAL ZONING MAP SO AS TO ESTABLISH SINGLE-FAMILY (R-1AA) ZONING ON THE ANNEXED PROPERTIES AT 443 EAST KINGS WAY, 1808, 1811, 1815, 1819, 1906, 1907, 1910, 1914, 1915, 1918, 1919, and 1923 STONEHURST ROAD, MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED HEREIN; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission intends to establish a municipal zoning designation on this property in compliance with the establishment of a similar Comprehensive Plan Future Land Use designation for said property; and

WHEREAS, on May 6, 2025, the Planning and Zoning Board held a public hearing on the proposed zoning map amendment set forth herein and made a recommendation of approval to the City Commission; and

WHEREAS, the establishment of municipal zoning meets the criteria established by Chapter 166, Florida Statutes and pursuant to and in compliance with law, notice has been given to Orange County and to the public by publication in a newspaper of general circulation to notify the public of this proposed Ordinance and of public hearings to be held.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY OF WINTER PARK, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1: That, Chapter 58 "Land Development Code", Article III, "Zoning" and the official Zoning Map is hereby amended so as to establish a Single-Family (R-1AA) district zoning on the annexed properties at 443 East Kings Way, 1808, 1811, 1815, 1819, 1906, 1907, 1910, 1914, 1915, 1918, 1919, and 1923 Stonehurst Road, and that all other maps in the Land Development Code reflect the annexation of this property into the City of Winter Park, said properties being more particularly described as follows:

Legal description: LOTS 1, 4, 5, 6, 7, 9, 10, 11, 13, 14, 15, 16 AND 19, STONEHURST ESTATES, AS RECORDED IN PLAT BOOK "U", PAGE 9, OF THE PUBLIC RECORDS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall become effective 31 days after adoption but shall not become effective if this Ordinance is challenged pursuant to Florida Statutes Section 163.3187 within 30 days after adoption. In that case it will not become effective until the State Land Planning Agency or the Administration Commission, respectively, issues a Final Order determining the Ordinance, in compliance, with Chapter 163, Florida Statutes.
